

RECRUITING INDIVIDUALS WITH MODERATE TO SEVERE TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY FOR A STUDY ON PEER SUPPORT

Study Title: A randomized controlled feasibility trial on the Ontario Brain Injury Association Peer Network (Phase 2)

We are looking for individuals with moderate to severe traumatic brain injury (TBI) to participate in a research study on peer support.

As part of the study, you will randomly be assigned to one of the following:

- Receiving support once/week
- Wait-list (i.e., you will not receive support for the duration of the study, but will be assigned a mentor after the 4-month study is complete).

Participation is completely voluntary and you will receive an honorarium for your time at the end of the study.

Eligibility criteria:

- Individual with moderate to severe TBI
 - o i.e. Glasgow Coma Scale ≤ 12
 - OR
 - o at the time of your injury, you lost consciousness and were admitted to the hospital
- 18 years or older
- Fluent in English
- Able to provide informed consent/have an available proxy who is able to provide informed consent
